Level 2 Extended Certificate

Entry Qualifications

A minimum of five GCSEs at Grade D/3 including English Language, from a mixture of GCSEs and equivalents.

What will I study?

At level two, you have the option to do a Cambridge Technical Level 2 Extended Certificate in Media. This will include the following units:

1. Introducing Media Products and Audiences (10 credits)
2. Planning and Producing a Media Product (10 credits)
3. Print-Based Advertising Media (10 credits)

These units will be confirmed when you enrol.

How will I study?

A lot of the course is practical and requires you to complete tasks. This will include: working individually or in groups; researching and presenting information; using camera equipment and editing software; and planning and developing creative work. There will also be lots of opportunities for classroom discussion.

How is the course examined?

There are four grades available: Pass, Merit, Distinction, and Distinction*. The course is assessed completely through coursework.

Where next?

A pass or above will help you to progress onto level 3 courses, provided you meet the other entry requirements.

What does the course combine well with?

Other subjects seen as complementing Media include Film, Graphics, Photography, and English. However, it may also fit with IT and Business.

Equivalents

This course is equivalent to 1.5 GCSEs at Grade C/4.

College Entry Requirements

A minimum of five GCSEs at Grade D/3 including English Language, from a mixture of GCSEs and equivalents.
