Assignment Details

As part of the Fashion & Textiles A-level course at WQE we nearly always link our practical work/samples/sketchbook work & garments to research into different designers/artists. We follow trends, allowing our observations to influence our own personal design work.

Task 1:

Visit my Pinterest site & look at my board 'ROCKET FUEL'

Observe the images that I have pinned to create this board, make a list of observations that you notice about the images.

Your observations should be single words e.g.

- Shimmer
- Dazzle
- Iridescent
- Shiny
- Lustre

You should write x 10 descriptive words (similar to the ones above, but obviously your own observations NOT mine) & then write the definition to each word alongside it e.g.

- Shimmer - ...'shine with a soft, slightly wavering light'.

Task 2:

Make your own board entitled 'Rocket Fuel – add your name' & pin no less than x 40 images of varying designers that truly reflect the theme.

Once you have completed this work, you should put your descriptive words & definitions & link to your own personal Pinterest board 'Rocket Fuel – your name' onto the sheet – see attachment in the 'submissions information' section above & submit your work as instructed – by the first lesson after the summer.
